



Wild Land needs your help now

The Scottish Government's National Planning Framework 4 is currently out for consultation. This will decide if, and how, wild land is to be treated in the planning system. It is therefore a very powerful document. We need you to show your support in one, or both, of the following ways:

1. Respond to the Consultation Document

The part of the consultation document concerning wild land is Policy 32 and it is Question 50 that needs to be answered (which is found in Part 3 – National Planning Policy of the document)

Point out how important wild land is (a national asset) and how vulnerable it is to development therefore the planning system must work on a presumption against development in wild land areas.
