Data protection and privacy rules are changing, as you will appreciate from all the letters and emails you may be receiving from the organisations you are in contact with. The new General Data Protection Regulation [GDPR] is intended to give you more control over how your data is used, and enables you to check and update the information held about you more easily.

To help us comply with the GDPR consent requirements we need you to confirm how you would like us to communicate with you. Please email us at admin@swlg.org.uk with the following:

1. Your full name
2. Your preferred email address
3. Your postal address
4. Your postal code
5. Also tell us whether or not you agree to us contacting you occasionally by email. We will only do this, for example, to keep you up to date with our work, any support you can give when we embark on a response to a development proposal, or if we want to ask you to support us in a campaign activity.

We are not sending out SAEs as we would prefer electronic communications on these points, and this will also help us to verify the accuracy of the email addresses we hold. If you would prefer to contact us by post please use the address above, sending the details asked for above at 1 to 5.

Our privacy policy and associated information is on our website at www.swlg.org.uk. The policy sets out how we will use your data [personal information], how we keep it secure, how long we will hold your data for and your rights as a data subject. Your personal data is safe with us and will never be released to third party companies for their marketing purposes.
